Currently before the Court is Defendant Rokoko Electronics’ Ex Parte Application for an extension of time to file an opposition to Plaintiff Matthew Walsh’s Motion for Partial Summary Judgment. (Dkt. No. 168.) Rokoko does not demonstrate why it is entitled to more time than what other litigants practicing this Court get to respond to motions for summary judgment. To the extent that Rokoko believes that it would be prejudiced because discovery has not yet closed, the proper avenue to raise such concerns would be to make a sufficient showing under Federal Rule of Civil Procedure 56(d) to deny, or delay consideration of, Walsh’s Motion.
