DECLARATION OF MATTHEW R. WALSH ISO
PLAINTIFF'S MOTION FOR RECONSIDERATION
re: Failure to Meet and Confer Declaration
(L.R. 37-2.4(a), L.R. 37-2.4(b) and L.R. 37-2.2)

1 I, Matthew R. Walsh, declare as follows:

2 I am the Plaintiff in this action. I have personal knowledge of the facts set
3 forth herein and, if called as a witness, could and would testify competently
4 thereto.
5

6 Since early discovery opened on September 9, 2025 (Docket #71), Plaintiff
7 has been unable to secure any discovery due to Defendant's stonewalling and ex-
8 parte interference. Defendant has failed to respond to any discovery requests and
9 refused to participate in a Rule 26(f) conference, canceling the scheduled
10 September 30, 2025 meeting and stating they will no longer meet and confer.
11

12 On October 10, 2025, Plaintiff filed his motion to compel, but the Court sua
13 sponte struck it for failing to meet and confer. This was due to Defendant's
14 obstruction, not Plaintiff's failure. The motion utilized an exception and included a
15 declaration of failure to meet and confer, but the Court struck it anyways, possibly
16 in error.
17

18 On October 17, 2025, the Court ordered Defendant to participate in the 26(f)
19 conference. Ten days later, this still has not occurred, violating the Court's
20 scheduling order deadline, Local Rule 37-1 and common findings that meet and
21 confers must occur within 10 days of notification. This makes Plaintiff's motion
22 and the Motion to Compel entirely proper under L.R. 37-2.4(b).

1 Despite numerous requests, Defendant remains unavailable for meet and
2 confer within deadlines set forth by the Court. Plaintiff submits this declaration
3 under the exceptions in L.R. 37-2.4(a), (b), and 37-2.2 and respectfully requests the
4 Court to hear this motion.
